What is a Podcast?

 A podcast is a series of audio or video digital media files which are distributed over the Internet by syndicated download, through Web feeds, to portable media players and personal computers. (Wikipedia)

RSS



- Really Simple Syndication
- RSS is a family of Web feed formats used to publish frequently updated works—such as blog entries, news headlines, audio, and video—in a standardized format. (Wikipedia)

iTunes



- iTunes is a proprietary digital media player application...used for playing and organizing digital music and video files. (Wikipedia)
 - When you sync your iPod all of your most recent podcasts are ready to be taken with you!
- Any "podcatcher" will do...

Bloggers Started It All

- The first RSS feeds were text only.
 - Blogs ("Weblogs")
- Attachments (pictures, audio & video) were included later.
- Do you still use text?
 - Yes! Show notes!

 - One-Click Installs

 - Audience Involvement
 - Blog Comments or an Online Bulletin Board
 - Listener Voicemails!
- Promoting Your Shows & Company!
 - Director's "Commentary"
 - Interviews with Actors
 - Do Ticket Giveaways to your Podcast Listeners!
